Ortholllinois Knee Surgeon Honored for Research

ROCKFORD, III. (Oct. 8, 2018) – Dr. Michael Chmell, an orthopedic surgeon who specializes in knee replacements at <u>Ortholllinois</u>, was honored for his research on alternative treatments for patients who are unable to undergo knee surgery.

Chmell achieved Top 3 enrollment for the Zimmer Biomet nSTRIDE research study. He conducted oversight for the project, and during a 15-month period, he assessed 69 screened patients, 24 of which were enrolled in the study. Ortholllinois' Dr. Ryan Enke also played a pivotal role in administering ultrasound-guided injections.

Recently published data from previous studies showed that patients with knee osteoarthritis who received the study injection experienced pain relief for up to 24 months. Ortholllinois' research department is evaluating its enrolled patients during a 12-month, post-injection period through June 2019.
