
Post-Operative Pain Management

The medications prescribed for post-operative pain are to be used as needed, not scheduled. Some pain medications, including Norco (hydrocodone) and Percocet (oxycodone) are habit forming and should be stopped as soon as possible.

You should contact us as early as possible if you need a prescription refill, as some pain medications cannot be called into the pharmacy. You will need to allow enough time for the prescription to be mailed to you should you not be able to pick up a physical prescription. Typically, we need to be notified 48-72 hours in advance. Medication refills will only be authorized during normal business hours.
