"Surgical smoke occurs every day in operating rooms and poses health risks to those exposed to it. AORN created this program so that every facility can understand the urgency and take steps to protect the health and safety of patients, nurses, doctors and support staff," said AORN CEO & Executive Director Linda Groah, MSN, RN, CNOR, NEA-BC, FAAN. "This Center of Excellence for Surgical Safety designation shows the community that the surgical teams at [this facility] are commited to providing high-quality care."

Surgical smoke is a hazardous byproduct of any surgery involving a laser or an electrosurgical unit. Although research, professional organizations, and the federal Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) identified surgical smoke as harmful many years ago, this byproduct continues to be a safety hazard in the operating room. The Center of Excellence in Surgical Safety: Smoke Evacuation (Go Clear[™]) Program was developed to help perioperative teams improve safety efforts and protect staff and patients from the hazards of surgical smoke.
