- 1-2 year caseload sharing with Mentor for immediate feedback and learning about various diagnoses and treatment progression
- One year formal Mentorship Program including monthly meetings for in-depth training in Outpatient Orthopedics
- Daily support using IDFPR Supervision Guidelines for new therapists prior to and after taking Boards
- Splinting workshops (5) with fellow OTs/Hand Therapists to improve skills, confidence, and efficiency on the most commonly fabricated orthoses
- CEU funds available for Medbridge self-guided learning opportunities and/or annual membership to ASHT
- Physician shadowing with four hand specialists
- Video library of Manual Therapy techniques
